By subscription of \$150 each if made on or before Saturday, July 14, 2012 or \$500 if made on or before Saturday, August 25, 2012 which should accompany the nomination, \$225 to pass the entry box, \$375 additional to start with \$75,000 guaranteed to be divided: \$45,000 to the owner of the winner, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250 to third, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. In addition to the purse, \$500 will be paid to the horses finishing sixth through last. Weights: Three-year-olds, 117 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$30,000 twice since June 8, 4 lbs.; of \$30,000 once since then, 6 lbs. (Claiming and starter races not considered). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Saturday, July 14, 2012 with 22. Late nominations closed Saturday, August 25, 2012 with 5. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (S)

TUJOES allowed to settle for half mile, bid four wide on the final turn, reached the front in the stretch and edged away. LAYERS steadied on the first turn, worked his way through traffic and continued well in a game effort. POLLARD'S BOY dropped back inside, angled wide rallying on the final turn but was too late. I'M SURE chased very wide throughout, earned a narrow lead at the quarter pole but tired. GONDWANAN raced close up between rivals then gave way in the stretch. GUNFIGHTER set a clear pace on the first turn and was finished after three quarters. MOORESTOWN JACKIE prompted the pace outside then stopped after half a mile. YOURHONORANDGLORY advanced to a narrow lead before the half and stopped in the stretch. MARCO'S FLING saved ground and steadily retreated.
