I'M TAPPED OUT saved ground, split rivals final turn, eased out and took the lead mid stretch and edged clear. HOTCHA DO IT broke slowly, advanced very wide, drifted wider under left handed pressure and couldn't gain. PAPA CARLOS moved up along the rail and finished willingly. WILLIES GRAND SLAM saved ground dueling for command and weakened. HERE'S NINO saved ground and faded late. DO A LEGGER, very wide, angled in and split rivals in stretch but was no factor. CHARITABLE ONE, well placed between foes, was left with the rail and tired. IS NOT, wide in second flight, tired. SIR COMMANDER showed little. FISHING CREEK vied for command two wide and stopped.
