Footnotes

HAYSTACK NEEDLE stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, drifted out late and was all out to the wire. UNBRIDLED DISPUTE was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch, could not get to the winner but gamely held the place. FEARLESS COWBOY was unhurried early while six wide and lost ground, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. MUSCADINE was void of early speed while seven wide and lost ground, had a late rally but too late. MAGIC TIGER was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. BLAME THE JOCKEY failed to menace. MICHAEL'S TRIFECTA showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. DODGY was no threat. GRANARDI flashed brief speed before stopping.
