JONATHAN'S GIRL dropped back near the inside, advanced on the turn, caught the pacesetters and edged away late. FIVE STAR MOMMA stalked the loose pacesetter, bid on the turn but was outfinished. OFFICER BIG RED chased very wide throughout and continued well to the finish. TRUE FEELINGS dropped back in the two path, moved between rivals on the turn then flattened out. GRAND KISSES trailed far behind then passed rivals while no factor. UNICORN GIRL set a clear pace well off the inside and was finished after five furlongs. MS. LYDIAN pursued close up outside, moved inside after a quarter and stopped.
