TEAM raced between foes under rating, was left with the rail on the final turn, rallied to the lead after finding a large opening along the rail entering the stretch and after opening a long lead, won with speed to spare. COUGAR AT HEART was wide and just off pace, was carried wider into stretch but then was no match. ISLAND TIME raced wide, angled in on the final turn and had no late gain. SECRET LONGING set pace off the rail, drifted out entering lane and faded. SALARY DRIVE, outside and just off pace, was carried out rallying into stretch and faded. LITTLE OFTEN ANNI was inside rating, gave up position without argument and was being eased through stretch. THE HORSES WERE LATE BEING LED TO THE STARTING GATE CAUSING ANOTHER DELAY IN POST TIME.
