CHAC MOOL vied outside, took over on the turn, drew away and lasted along the inside. TINY PREDICAMENT settled in the two path, advanced into the stretch and made a gradual late gain. REGAL STRIKE dropped back early four wide, angled to the two path and closed well. SUPER ROBUSTO raced just off the pacesetters three wide, bid but was outfinished. HUFF 'N HUGHES trailed early, advanced into the far turn then flattened out. LORD KYLE'S QUEST led narrowly inside then began faltering on the turn. COVER PRICE chased five wide and gave way readily. BRAHMAN broke sluggishly, rushed up inside then stopped after half a mile.
