MENIFEE SIX settled five wide off the pace, advanced seven wide into the stretch, surged down the stretch and edged clear late. ACOPANDPROUDOFIT prompted the pace three wide, led at the top of the stretch but was outfinished. MACHO MO MON vied between rivals in the two path and continued gamely to the finish. NEVER RIGHT JOEY raced close up near the inside then went evenly in the late stages. PAL PETEY urged between rivals, found a seam near the top of the stretch but lacked a rally. IL TERRAZZO steadied in the opening sixteenth then was always outrun. DIXIE SLAM dropped back early and was never a factor. QUAY LIME GUY broke awkwardly, rushed up inside, set the pace for half a mile then stopped.
