Footnotes

PHILLY ACE saved ground under rating, lacked room racing into the far turn, waited briefly for racing room near the quarter pole, swung out three wide to secure room, took the lead leaving furlong grounds and lasted. ROADHOG was well placed between foes, steadied briefly and moved to the rail on the final turn and then was quickly steered to the outside, raced four wide into stretch, closed and just missed. SIR CADIAN broke slowly, was always well placed between under a snug hold, took the lead near mid stretch and then weakened slightly late. WINCHILL saved ground setting the early pace, faded late. I'M SURE was wide and never far back, had no response. SACO RIVER raced off the rail and failed to menace. LEMON ZING, wide and just off the pace, faded through the stretch. JACK ARMSTRONG, racing just off the rail and just off pace, gave way.
