ESPRESSO ROYALE vied for the lead inside, edged clear on the turn, repulsed a challenge near mid-stretch and drew off again. ROYALE HARBOR raced close up four wide, loomed boldly in the stretch but could not get by. ROAD TRIP dropped back early, advanced wide on the turn and offered only a mild rally. MOVIN TO UTOPIA held a narrow advantage early then yielded in the stretch. PRINCESS SAPPHIRE was outrun while racing wide and never menaced. ASHCRAFT SILVER chased close up in the two path and lacked a rally. HARD TO STEAL prompted the pace three wide then came up empty in the stretch. HAILTOTHEVICTORS was taken up sharply between rivals into the far turn and dropped back.
