THIS AIN'T NO BULL rated outside the pacesetter, bid to the front midway on the turn, moved clear and lasted. BELLE'S BIG BOY chased outside, rallied on the turn then made a gradual late gain. GRAND SPORT dropped far back then showed some late energy. BIG BLACKJACK pursued the pacesetter inside, angled out on the turn but flattened. GUSTO DI LIMONE dropped back outside and was never a factor. ROI D'ECOSSE broke awkwardly, rushed up inside to set the pace then came up empty in the stretch. SO BOLD dropped back very wide and was always outrun. JETSDARKSTORM chased inside and gave way readily.
