WHAT'S YOUR EXCUSE, just off the rail and just off the pace, closed well despite having his over girth strap come loose at the head of the stretch. SUNDAY BRUNCH set the pace two wide and weakened late. PROPER FREUD saved ground vying for command and tired. RONNIE CLARK saved ground advancing but then flattened out. GIANTEX broke slowly and failed to menace. PRESTONS PRINCE, outside and just off the early pace, tired. HUNTING GOLD MOTEL broke slowly and showed little. PARTYGUID, wide and just off the pace, tired badly.
