STREET BALLAD raced outside, took the lead leaving the turn and gamely held on. NAVY CROSS saved ground early, eased out on the far turn, challenged but then hung. YES I'M SURE raced between foes, took up on the turn and gained show. ACRO'S GAME, outrun saving ground, swung out for the stretch but was no threat. ROVIN MAN raced wide while just off the pace and tired. DEAN THE MAN, just off the rail and just off the pace, was no factor. FAIRY SNOW set the pace just off the rail and had nothing left. BIRCH RUN FAST, off the rail, drifted in early stretch and tired. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF YES I'M SURE AGAINST NAVY CROSS FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE FAR TURN WAS DISMISSED.
