SLICK IDEA set the pace between foes, edged away late. JET SET VINNY, off slowly, raced off the rail, eased out wider and rallied. HUFF 'N HUGHES was off slowest, steadied on the turn, bore out into stretch and rallied. MUTINY prompted inside winner and faded. SEATTLE LOUIE was well placed between foes, tired. FOREST MEADOW raced wide, was carried wider into stretch. EXTREME DREAM, wide and just off the pace, tired. CONCERTO'S THUNDER three wide and well placed early, tired. HILL CROSSING WAS ORDERED SCRATCHED ON THE ADVICE OF THE VETERINARIAN. WAGERS ON HIM WERE REFUNDED.
