HOT SPA vied inside, drew clear on the turn then increased her lead in the final furlong while kept to a drive. GIFT WRAP outrun early, advanced in the two path, appeared a brief menace but proved no match in the late stages. UNBRIDLED ELLA broke a step slowly, moved wide on the turn and closed well without threatening. ENNIE'S LAMENT chased outside and lacked a rally. WELLINGTONS APPEAL set the early pace off the inside and faltered after half a mile. LITTLE MISS steadied between rivals in the opening furlong and had no further response. TRUST N MADAM bore out badly at the start, advanced three wide then stopped after five furlongs. KEEP THE TICKET raced within striking range early then gave way readily. CHANGE THE VERDICT broke in a complete tangle and raced far back throughout.
