MOONLIT RIVER took lead at once, set the pace off the rail and extended under a drive. LADY S bobbed slightly leaving the gate, saved ground just off the pace, fell back, eased out entering the stretch, drifted wider and gained place. NOAH'S EXPENSE was between rivals early and then was left with the rail, took up chase but had no kick. ESPRESSO ROYALE prompted the pace while wide, drifted out and faded. CHARLIES DREAM was outrun to stretch, passed tiring foes. PLEASE BE QUIET raced wide while just off the pace and tired. MISSTERIA failed to menace. BENIMARI stumbled at the start, raced wide and tired.
