ASIA GRAY outrun early in the two path, bid wide into the stretch, reached the front in the final sixteenth and edged clear. HEADLINE STORY was outrun to the stretch then closed well outside too late. LILLIEBETH vied inside, dropped back briefly on the turn then came again for the show. NANNY CAY dueled outside, edged clear near the quarter pole then shortened stride in the final furlong. CELTIC COUNTRY dropped back outside and lacked a rally. DIVA'S LAST DANCE chased inside early, moved out on the turn and gave way. WILD AND CATTY was always outrun. FALSE STORM trailed throughout.
