THIS SATURDAY quickly moved clear under rating then extended her margin through the stretch in a moderate drive. MELISSA SONG pursued the pacesetter outside, continued well and lasted for the place. ROYAL START split rivals advancing on the turn, angled wide and made a gradual gain. QUIET LIVEING saved ground throughout and closed well while no threat. TUFF TRI chased close up early, moved three wide on the turn then proved empty in the stretch. MY BLUE RIBBON forced the pace inside for half a mile then gave way. SALLY'S CONTENDER raced outside and was always outrun. POORLITTLERICHGIRL trailed throughout.
