REASON TO DRINK vied for the lead inside, edged clear in mid-stretch then drifted out and lasted under steady urging. STAND PROUD dropped back early five wide, advanced wide on the turn and found his best stride too late. CALVIN'S DREAM lacked his usual early speed, made a menacing three wide move on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. TOWN SQUARED dueled outside to the stretch then weakened. BIG CITY DEPUTY raced just off the pace inside, moved in the two path on the turn and never threatened. THREE O'CLOCK ROCK prompted on the rail in the opening sixteenth then steadily faded.
