**Footnotes**

NATHAN RIDGE raced close up outside, edged to the front near the eighth pole and drew clear in the final furlong. AWESOME REVIEW set a clear pace inside to the stretch and gave way grudgingly. SILVER PRADO raced off the pace four wide and made a gradual gain through the stretch. FAMOUS PATRIOT angled wide after a quarter, advanced on the final turn then moved seven wide into the lane and rallied mildly. SURE START dropped back early, moved four wide on the final turn and flattened out in the stretch. SMALLTOWNMAN was outrun near the inside for half a mile and never menaced. PARABOLA moved closer between rivals into the final turn then weakened in the stretch. LINEBACKER bobbled soon after the start, was put to a drive on the final turn but yielded. ANDYSUN saved ground while close up early and was finished on the final turn. JOE BAGADONUTS dropped back early and was always outrun.
