Footnotes

HARD TO NAME broke sluggishly then reserved off the pace into the far turn, bid inside on the turn then edged away in the final furlong. SOUTHERN HONOR set a pressured pace just off the inside then yielded to the winner in the stretch. STEPHEN A dropped well back four wide and closed strongly too late. RES JUDICATA prompted the pace three wide, bid on the turn but weakened in the stretch. DOS ORO pressed the pace in the two path and was finished midway on the turn. LONDON CITIZEN raced within striking range while wide in the opening quarter then gave way readily. There was a five minute delay in the post time for this race after the horses left the paddock with three minutes to post.
