ONE OF THE BEST stumbled at the start, saved ground throughout, bid into the stretch and was up in the final sixteenth. MISTYCAL LIGHT set the pace just off the inside, increased his lead on the turn but weakened late. TEJANOS ELIMINATOR dropped back early in the two path, was hard urged on the but flattened out in the stretch. STORM THE FIELD forced the pace outside to the stretch then faltered. LING LING QI trailed to the stretch racing wide and lacked a solid rally. CRACK THE OPUS prompted the issue three wide to the quarter pole then faded.
