STORM PROOF saved ground and failed to menace. MAPLE SONG raced between foes and tired badly. YOUNG TROUBADOR steadied after the start. TRYAN dropped back steadily. STEALING SARATOGA failed to menace. CHEROKEE EXPRESS showed little.
