TRAFFIC LIGHT held a narrow lead outside, moved to the rail when clear on the turn and extended his margin under mild urging in an impressive score. FRIENDS INDEED was close up five wide early, bid into the stretch but was no match for the winner. MR. SORGUCCI chased in the two path on the turn, angled wide advancing into the stretch and had only a mild rally. DILATORY dropped back inside then showed some late energy. AZU WERE chased between rivals and continued well while no threat. JIMMY WINDOWS forced the pace outside for half a mile and weakened. BURNT TOAST was close up in the two path to the turn then gave way. DOUBLE DUTCH BUS vied between rivals early then continued well to the stretch then faded. DRUMS OF WAR broke sluggishly, chased wide and was never a factor. EL CATRIN was outrun in the four path and weakened steadily. ROMANCING THE GOLD broke a step slowly and was in tight early then raced wide and was always outrun.
