Footnotes

TUJOES settled in the two path, awaited room on the final turn, found a seam and split foes near the quarter pole, rallied and edged clear. LAYERS raced close up inside, held a narrow lead at the quarter pole and continued gamely to the finish. LUBANGO stalked the pace four wide, bid on the final turn then flattened out in the stretch. ARLO was just off the pace under a firm rating hold, vied to the stretch then tired. J W BLUE angled inside after the opening quarter and lacked a solid rally. HERMOSILLO set the pace off the inside, vied on the final turn and gave way. EMPIRE ON FIRE raced close up early in the two path, was steered wide and gave way readily.
