### Footnotes

TOP THE PODIUM put to the whip early, chased four wide, rallied into the stretch, closed well and edged clear late. FLASHY FELIPE prompted the pace outside, dropped back on the turn then came again in the stretch but was outfinished. KISSING BANDIT quickly moved clear to the eighth pole then weakened. VOWS TO BE BROKEN was close up inside to the far turn, raced in the two path on the turn and faltered. KEY TO THE EMPIRE outrun early, bore out at the far turn then passed fading rivals. CODE PURPLE chased three wide just off the pace then faded. WE ARE DUE raced outside and lacked a rally. MILITARY PIKE moved inside on the turn and was never a factor. CAPTAIN TWITCH saved ground and never menaced. CHIEF WILD EAGLE trailed throughout.
