RADIO ROW outrun early, bid inside on the turn, drew clear in mid-stretch then held a rival safe in the final sixteenth. CITY GENIUS dropped back early, advanced wide on the turn, moved six wide into the lane and was too late. BACHMAN prompted the pace outside, edged to the front on the turn then proved empty in the stretch. BEAUREAL was close up between rivals for half a mile and lacked a rally. MADE IN PERU set the pace off the inside then began faltering before half a mile. SILENT BOLT trailed to the stretch and was never a factor. BRAHMAN pressed the pace in the two path then stopped through the stretch.
