MANDATORY forced the pace outside then wore down the pacesetter in the final furlong. SHE'SA BEAUTYQUEEN set a pressured pace then gave way grudgingly in the stretch. EMPIRE DIVA was just off the leaders in the two path and continued well to the finish. GIMME AN INCH saved ground throughout and lacked a solid rally. SURGING EMPRESS broke sluggishly and passed rivals while no menace. SILVER UNO chased outside and gradually weakened. APRIL REIGN DANCER dropped far back and passed rivals while no factor. DANCING AT NICKIES was outrun wide from the outset and faltered. DON'TMESSW'LOUISA gave way readily.
