Footnotes

BATTIER pursued the loose pacesetter outside, led into the stretch, moved well clear and lasted. GAME EFFORT steadied when crowded between rivals soon after the start, saved ground and closed strongly too late. RAVEN'S TALE split rivals advancing on the turn, angled wide into the stretch and continued willingly. TIME FOR SPRING chased very wide and continued well while no threat. SMILIN TED raced close up, bid near the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. TRUST ISSUES raced in mid-pack and was never a factor. PAYDAY PROMISE quickly sprinted clear inside then stopped after half a mile. SCIACCA raced within striking range three wide then retreated. SUPER LOUIE raced between rivals down the backstretch then gave way on the turn. QUALITY CAT chased close up inside and weakened steadily.
