Footnotes

LEROIDESSIUX set the pace outside, shook loose to be clear mid stretch and won under strong handling. ARROGANT OFFICER came out after the start, was steadied along lacking room through much of the backstretch, eased out, lugged in entering the lane and closed well. FIELD PASS was steadied after start, raced inside, lacked room on the backstretch and was steered to the outside and closed. DANNY NEWMAN saved ground prompting the pace and weakened. BELLE'S BIG BOY raced wide, bid on the turn and then gave way. ISTANBULLY, well placed between foes, was bumped in early stretch while retreating. BOS'N ALWYNE saved ground and tired. PARTY HALO had speed for a quarter mile. NARBONA PASS, bumped leaving the gate, was no factor.
