SOK SOK dueled inside, edged to the front on the turn, drew off in mid-stretch and lasted. WAKING UP chased four wide, advanced on the turn and closed well too late. AREPEATEE chased between foes and continued well to the finish. SOUPA MON held a narrow lead outside down the backstretch and weakened in the stretch. BOJAN dropped back outside and never menaced. SERENDIPPER MOON saved ground early and lacked a rally. MOOSE MAN raced close up inside to the stretch then yielded. PRIVATE WISH dropped well back and was never a factor. QUAY LIME GUY advanced in the two path in the opening quarter and faltered. MR. WINDJAMMER dropped far behind and was always outrun. AFRICAN KNIGHT raced very wide and gave way readily.
