### Footnotes

FULL LIQUIDITY made a strong run around foes rallying, took the lead near mid stretch, was clear and then held on under strong handling. BELIEVE IN WEST saved ground, eased out rallying and closed strongly. STRIKING POWER raced out from the rail, took the lead on the final turn but then weakened. THE DUKE RULES set the pace just off the rail and then faded late. MAXIMOSO saved ground and failed to menace. CELERITAS PLUS failed to menace. AGENT OF CHAOS bobbled leaving the gate, raced wide while never far back, tired. WHAT NOW was off slow, took up sharply off heels entering the first turn, was wide and dull. JUST A GUY raced two wide in second flight, tired.
