TIGER GRR was two wide in second flight, drifted out wider through stretch and gained place. BIG SMOOTH racing three wide, had no rally. BRIMSTONE AND FIRE saved ground in second flight and faded. DUBAI'S DEBUT vied for command racing wide and tired. OLD BUD saved ground. TIP OF THE SWORD raced between foes and failed to menace. BONA FIDE (ARG) raced widest and tired.
