HULA PARTY quickly went to the front to control the issue and held off the challenge of BOSS'S RULES. BOSS'S RULES racing within striking distance, circled six wide on the far turn then responded well to close the gap. NOAH'S EXPENSE was well placed close to the pace but lacked the needed closing response. ALMOST GRECIAN moved up menacingly on the far turn then needed more in the stretch. CHARLIES DREAM failed to be a threat. BETT ON RUTHIE lunged just prior to the start to get away poorly then was forwardly placed to the far turn and flattened out. LILY LYNN was well placed close to the pace for six furlongs then weakened. CHARIOT CHAR tired.
