AGAIN AGAIN AGAIN raced between foes, rallied to the lead five wide entering the lane and drew off to win in hand. I'M TAPPED OUT dueled for command inside and lasted for place. GULF OF ADEN was between rivals early, eased out entering the stretch but was no real threat. SUBLIME TWIST, three wide early, split rivals on the far turn and tired. ROMOLO'S FRIAR took the lead four wide and then gradually gave way. LEAD ME LORD lunged slightly at the start, eased out and was no factor. FAT JACK vied for command two wide and tired. SOLDIER'S SOUP saved ground while well placed and faltered. TRACEY PAL FRIDAY raced wide and stopped.
