**Footnotes**

IMPRESS THE CHIEF raced very wide, drifted wider in early stretch, was straightened away and drew off driving. BELLAMY XPRESS set the pace two wide but then was no match. CHIEF THUNDERCLOUD was outrun early, raced outside and passed faders. BIGLEAGUEPROSPECT was wide and just off the pace, tired. QUITE A LEGACY didn't break sharply, was hustled up off the rail and tired. BROOKLYN PROUD raced very wide, steadied off winners heels entering the lane and gave way TRULY A CHAMP raced wide and failed to menace. FLASHY BULLET showed little. HEAVY DUTY was well placed between foes and tired badly. GREAT BIG BANG broke slowly. BIG RON WEST saved ground stalking the pace and tired.
