SPEEDING TRAIN advanced three wide early, eased out a bit wider through stretch, closed strongly and was along in time. MAJORITY DECISION raced outside, took the lead briefly deep stretch but was outfinished. NIBIRU'S RETURN eased out on the backstretch, took the lead and then weakened. COLORADO GUY WINS was well placed while outside, was left with the rail and weakened late. SPIN OUT, off slowest, saved ground and had no rally. KAT'S HOPE moved up inside winner, flattened out. NOIFSWATSORBUTS saved ground setting the pace and tired. O WHEN THE SAINTS failed to menace. PLEASANT EARTH was outside and just off the pace, faltered.
