MIDNIGHT CALL prompted the pace racing two wide, collared the leader a furlong out then drove clear. PARK AVENUE APPEAL quickly went to the front to set the pace to midstretch then was not good enough. RESPIGHI was carried very wide leaving the turn then continued well to close the gap. BELIEVE IN FUN was outrun to the stretch then found his best stride too late. PHILLY THUNDER lacked the needed rally. WIDOWS EVIL EYE was carried very wide leaving the turn. SONG FOR KRISMIKE drifted wide around the turn. KIWI STORM drifted wide on the turn then tired. SMOKIN OPAL showed little. BOCCO BOY was no factor.
