SENOR LOUIE raced off the rail while never far back, eased out a bit wider and closed. WRIGHT RENDEZVOUS raced wide while just off the pace, closed. COLOUR COURT broke slowly, raced wide and rallied. SUNNY DEFRERE was off slow and then came in and bumped with foe soon after and was no real threat. WHODAT SAY WHODAT saved ground while just off the pace, tired. HOLLYWOOD LOU, wide, failed to menace. DANCING BUKI raced wide and showed little. FIVESIXSEVEN came and contributed to the bumping with SUNNY DEFRERE and tired badly.
