CACTUS CITY ROAD moved up between rivals leaving the turn and loomed boldly through the stretch but was not good enough. COLD PRECISION was outrun to the stretch then finished with good energy but was too late. COULDASHUDDAWOODA showed the way racing removed from the inside rail then faded in the final furlong. TROUBLE IN DODGE was forwardly placed to the stretch then weakened. PART ONE lacked a rally. LEAWOOD TEEL prompted the pace then had little left for the drive. QUALITY HARBOR tired from his early effort.
