BOBBY BOB set the pace between foes and then stopped. LUANNS BOY was well off the rail and stopped. SMART PHONE saved ground and stopped. BALLET ENCORE raced wide prompting the pace and stopped. SHERRILL'S HERO showed little. HARRY THE TANK broke slowly and trailed.
