LIAMS LEGEND rallied three wide into the stretch, drifted in on DOCTOR DINERO in the final furlong then drove clear. DOCTOR DINERO vied for the lead from the outset and was checked when the winner drifted in in midstretch then drifted out into MAGICAL DREAMER in deep stretch. MAGICAL DREAMER broke sharp to dispute the pace and was pushed wide in deep stretch. EIGHT KARET LIE failed to be a threat. L'EMPEREUR stumbled at the start. EXPLOSIVE BOOK lacked a rally. WITTY KID tired. KASH KOW KAZ vied for the early lead and tired. WEBSTER CLASSIC showed little. An objection by the rider of DOCTOR DINERO against the winner for interference in the stretch was not allowed. DOCTOR DINERO was disqualified to third for interference in deep stretch following an objection by the rider of MAGICAL DREAMER.
