BELUSHI moved up wide between rivals into the stretch then ran down the leader. LINK SUANCES rallied between rivals into the stretch, gained the lead in the final furlong then was not quite good enough. GRANDAD BUD dueled for the lead racing off the inside rail then faded in the final furlong. OVERNIGHT FLING moved up wide leaving the turn then lacked the needed closing bid. CATCH ME KAZ bobbled at the start then dueled for the lead racing three abreast and faded in the drive. FINE COGNAC broke a step slowly then failed to be a threat. BELIEVE ITS TRUE dueled for the lead between horses and tired. WHITE REEF showed little.
