FRANK AND DINO vied for command three wide, was carried out entering the lane, took the lead near mid stretch and won under strong handling. TIME FOR SPRING vied for command between foes, drifted out entering the lane and weakened slightly. FLY EAGLE FLY rallied wide and challenged on the turn, was also carried wider and weakened. VIVA LOS FELIZ broke slowly, angled out on the turn and gave way. GOODS IS CRACKIN raced wide and failed to menace. LYRICAL LAD fell back after an awkward start and then showed little. KILLTHEMESSENGER disputed the pace inside and tired. EL BAGRE raced wide while just off the pace, faltered.
