SHALER broke slowly and then was reserved saving ground, unleashed a strong run near the stretch, eased off the rail and split foes deep stretch, took the lead final sixteenth and won with speed to spare. SHOOK THE HOOK was off slowly and then was hustled up to take the lead while moving to the rail, was clear in mid stretch but couldn't hold off winner while clearly second best. LEXIS HERO came in bumped with foe after the break, prompted two wide and then weakened. GRAY NOT BAY saved ground under snug hold, eased out and flattened out. FORWARD MOMENTUM came out contributing to the bumping after the start, saved ground, drifted out under left handed pressure through deep stretch. HEAD GEAR broke slowly, raced wide, drifted wider into stretch. ENGLISH MANOR raced two wide in second flight and then tired.
