SHILOH'S VINE circled rivals leaving the far turn then ran down the leader to win going away. DELICATE GENIUS quickly went to the front to set the pace then was not good enough for the winner. REFLECTING RIVA moved closer on the far turn then could gain little in the drive. STORM RUBI moved up menacingly on the far turn then weakened in the drive. SMARTY SLEWY failed to be a threat. THEDAMAGEISDONE prompted the early pace then tired. SECRET DAB lacked a rally. FORBIDDEN BREW tired. QUINCY LEE was used up early.
