BUDDY BE GOOD ducked out leaving the gate, dueled and took the lead, was clear in mid stretch and then just failed. I'LL STAKE U saved ground to stretch, swung out and had no rally. AZU WERE was wide and just off the pace, weakened. BRAVACCIO passed tiring foes. RIGHTEOUS AGAIN was in tight after the start and then forced wide, had no rally. DISTINCT HONOR vied for command just off the rail and tired. PANDER raced outside and tired. SENOR CHILI showed little.
