STOLEN DANCE vied inside early, repulsed repeated challenges from the entymates then drew away through the stretch. END ZONE ANTICS forced the pace outside to the stretch then weakened. RUMACK was unruly prior to the start then prompted the pace three wide and tired. MISS TEA PARTY dropped back early saving ground, moved closer after a half then faltered. HIGH TOP SNEAKERS trailed for five furlongs then passed fading rivals. FAULTY PROCESS chased close up to the final turn then gave way. CAREFREE WONDER was within striking range for half a mile then stopped. BELL'S ROYAL MISS dropped back early and was never a factor. BECKY BELLE raced very wide and stopped abruptly.
