Footnotes

IRISH PRINCE (NZ) rated for mile and half, made a move near the mid point to gain the advantage, then held sway to the wire. WOODMONT raced unhurried for two miles, then advanced with a late run. SHARP FACE was always close, moved up slightly to be in a striking position on the final circuit then finished evenly. NO FAST MOVES three wide on the opening turn, raced near mid pack to the lane but was empty late. SHADY VALLEY pressed the pace for a mile and half, faded shortly thereafter and was unable to offer a late run. EARMARK showed an early turn of foot to set the pace in the opening mile, bolted nearing the fourth fence taking an awkward jump then tired. PRAISE THE PRINCE (NZ) failed to menace. NAVESINK VIEW was outrun. ALISON'S TRICK pressed the early speed, gained the advantage when EARMARK lost ground after the fourth fence, gave way willingly, then pulled up. MONTE BIANCO (IRE) was in good position most way, tired and fell. ALL RACES AT THE IROQUOIS STEEPLECHASE ARE HAND TIMED.
