TRIPLE DIP raced without urgency on the first circuit, moved up to lead the second flight, took command with three sixteenths remaining, was steadied a bit after an awkward landing on the last fence then finished strong. MEET AT ELEVEN (IRE) bided his time for two miles, moved up along the inside to take a lead five furlongs from the wire then gave way under pressure from the winner. DELTA PARK trailed the field for most of the way from well back, was set to task with a sustained run in the late going and closed strong. PLUM BRUSH was not a factor. YIN YANG tired in the late going and pulled up. HE'S A CONNIVER was well in front shortly after the start, remained well clear to the final circuit then tired badly and was pulled up. PROFESSOR MAXWELL tired after the first circuit and was pulled up.
