RED NINETY SEVEN stalked the pace while running wide, gained command entering the stretch, drew off, but was all out to hold off EN CALIENTE who was unhurried early while racing outside, found her best stride late and was gaining. SPOON FUDGE dueled and gained command on the turn, but then weakened late stretch. DREAMS COUNT was well placed, rallied, but then failed to sustain a bid. IRISH TEMPEST stalked the pace evenly with no rally. LOOKSLIKEAMILLION failed to menace, ran evenly. NASKRA'S REASON raced in the middle of the pack, was no threat. EXTREME MISS ran off in the post parade, was no factor. SEA DOLLAR flashed brief speed but was through after a half and stopped. LEADMETOGLOORY good early speed, gave way, dropped back. RETRACING dueled while running inside, but stopped. LUCKY DOLLAR stumbled and was taken up at the start, was no factor.
